## Minutes

### Call to Order

President Dan Puetz, Sr. called the meeting to order at 6:05 PM.

### Roll Call of Officers

### Seattle Parks Director of Golf Report

Wilkinson provided the Board information about Jackson Park capital improvement projects that have been funded and will be implemented this year. Among them: paved asphalt cart paths, a driving range (where the 10<sup>th</sup> hole is located), perimeter paths around the course, rebuilding the cart barn and means to eliminate the bottleneck caused by the layout of the first hole. He went on to say the design team that consulted on proposed changes to the West Seattle Golf Course will do the same at Jackson.

### Minutes

The minutes of the February Trustees meeting were approved as read.

### Financial Report

Jim Gaskill advised the club had \$1,728.05 in the bank. At this time, the club has only members 23 paid up members with 2011 members, including three juniors and one super senior.

### President's Report

Puetz, Sr. announced no one so far has shown an interest in the two Board vacancies, Vice President and one Trustee. Scott Furrow advised he would like to take over the VP position. The Board unanimously ratified the appointment.

### Membership /Handicap Committee

GHIN posting begins on this date. John Clements advised that members who have not renewed by April 27 will be dropped from the GHIN rolls on that date.

**Tournament Committee Report** – Clements reported that all changes in the tournament schedule that were suggested in February have been made.

- **Jackson Park Classic** – Scott Furrow provided a report on preliminary plans his committee has developed for the inaugural Jackson Park Classic, a two

day event open to all on September 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>. At this time nothing has been formalized.

- **Almost Spring** – The format for the kickoff OHGC event will be an 18 hole gross/net competition.
- **Professional Participation** – Dan advised Jackson Park professionals will be allowed to compete in OHGC tournaments provided they are dues paying members with GHIN handicaps. They will not be able to compete for low gross prizes, just net competition.
- **Weekend Promotional Table** – President Puetz asked for Board volunteers to man a promotional table near the putting green to recruit new members teeing off over upcoming weekends. A number of Trustees expressed interest in doing so.
